Parade Marshals

Walking entries are encouraged, but not required to provide Parade marshals.

All float entries, large and small must provide 2 marshals who will not be assigned to your entry. Marshals are required to carry a cell phone.

Marshals cannot be part of your entry. (Ex. As banner bearers or handing out materials.)
